Subject:- Grant of Conditional Permission to R.B. Ayurvedic Medical College & Hospital, Jalesar Road, Agra- 283126, Uttar Pradesh (Inst. ID-AYU0390) with intake capacity of 100 seats in UG (BAMS) course, under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2024-25 and relevant regulations thereunder-reg.

Sir/Madam,

With reference to the subject mentioned above, I am directed to inform you that in pursuance of the provision of National commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020, the Indian Medicine Central Council Act,1970 (48 of 1970) has been repealed with effect from the 11th day of June, 2021. With effect from the said date, the Central Council of Indian Medicine constituted under sub-division (1) of section 3 of the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 (48 of 1970) shall stand dissolved. Now, in exercise of the powers conferred by subsection (3) of the section 1 of the said Act, the Central Government hereby notifies that all the provisions of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020 has been come into force with effect from the 11th day of June, 2021 and as per regulation 59 (2) of The National Commission for Indian System of Medicine ACT, 2020, Medical standards, requirements and other provisions of the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 and the rules and regulations made there under shall continue to be in force and operate till new standards or requirements are specified under this Act or the rules and regulations made there under.

Further, the provision of concerned regulations which are inconsistent with the provision of NCISM Act, 2020 shall not be applicable.

- 1. Further, to assess the available facilities of teaching, non-teaching, hospital staff, practical training and other infrastructure facilities at your college namely R.B. Ayurvedic Medical College & Hospital, Jalesar Road, Agra- 283126, Uttar Pradesh (Inst. ID-AYU0390), inspection of your College was conducted on 30.01.2024 & 31.01.2024 and re-visited on 18.03.2024 & 19.03.2024 in hybrid mode as a part of annual visitation by the visitation team of Medical Asessment and Rating Board, NCISM to process the Conditional Permission with intake capacity of 100 seats in UG (BAMS) course under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2024-25.
- 2. Further, the hearing with regard to faculty suspected to be working only on paper but physically not present was conducted on 03.07.2024 & 04.07.2024 and recommendation of the hearing committee was placed in the 97th Board meeting of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) held on 26.07.2024. Further, corrections in the minutes were made as directed by the board and minutes were placed again in the 98th Board Meeting of MARB held on 19.07.2024 and same was approved that five of your faculty who were suspected to be working only on paper, namely Dr. Bishwambhar Kumar Pathak (AYXX00495), Dr. Geeta Gupta (AYKS00718), Dr. Keshav Kumar Pathak (AYXX00527), Dr. Shaik Mateen Ahmed (AYRS00658) & Dr. Usha Jangir (AYPS01168) cannot be considered as regular teachers and same was communicated to you vide letter ref. no. Teacher Verification/MARB/2024 dated 27.07.2024.
- 3. Thereafter, the assessment report was placed in the 103rd Board meeting of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) held on 21.08.2024 & 22.08.2024. On careful examination of the assessment report it is found that your college is not fulfilling the notified & approved criteria, due to the following shortcoming:

a) Teaching staffs:-

- 4. Further, Medical Assessment and Rating Board, NCSIM was in receipt of a letter vide ref no. RBAMC/2024/367 dated 16.08.2024 regarding the payment of imposed monetary penalty of Rs. 1 crore 25 Lakh in 05 installments to your college on the condition that your college should pay the penalty amount of Rs. 1 crore 25 Lakh in 05 installments and same was placed in the 103rd Board meeting of Medical Assessment and Rating Board, NCSIM held on 21.08.2024 & 22.08.2024. Board accepted the request of the college to pay the monetary penalty of Rs. 1 crore 25 lakh in 05 equal installments and same was communicated to you vide letter of even no. dated 28.08.2024. Further, the 1st installment of Rs. 25 Lakhs has been received through RTGS no. HDFCR52024081784853703 from HDFC bank Firozabad dated 17.08.2024.
- 5. Further, as per regulation 3(3) (a) of MSR, 2016, the college is fulfilling the basic eligibility criteria for issuance of conditional permission for the academic year 2024-25. Hence the Board decided to issue the Conditional Permission with 100 seats in UG (BAMS) course under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2024-25.
- 6. Therefore, conditional permission is issued to R.B. Ayurvedic Medical College & Hospital, Jalesar Road, Agra- 283126, Uttar Pradesh (Inst. ID-AYU0390) with intake capacity of 100 seats in UG (BAMS) course under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2024-25 subject to the condition that college is fulfilling the following requirements: -
 - I. The college shall submit an undertaking in the form of affidavit duly notarized within one month explaining the details of providing EPF and ESI facilities to the teaching, non-teaching staff of the Colleges/Hospitals and regularly paying the same as per the provisions of Employees' Provident Funds and Miscellaneous Provisions Act, 1952 & ESI Act, 1948 and relevant Rules and Regulations.
 - II. It is further informed that minimum 15% of undergraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity with 100 seats shall be treated as all India quota. The counseling for seats under all India quota shall be conducted by respective counseling authority as designated by Central Government for A.Y. 2024-25 and counseling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned Counseling Authority of that State/UT. The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction of the Central Government/NCISM for all India quota or the students admitted thereunder.
- III. It is also informed that determination of fee and all other charges in respect of 50% of seats in private Medical Institutions and deemed to be University should be as per the guidelines issued by NCISM vide ref no. BUSS/Fee/ASU/2022-23 dated 16.09.2022. Fees of the remaining 50% of seats are to be fixed as per the guidelines of Fee Fixation/Regulatary Committee (FRC) of respective State/UT/Deemed to be University.
- 7. Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as invalid and action will be initiated under NCISM Act & Regulations thereunder.

- 8. Further, as per Sub-section (7) of Section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020, the Medical Assessment and Ratina Board for Indian System of Medicine may conduct evaluation and assessment of any University or medical institution at any time, either directly or through any other expert, having integrity and experience in medical profession, without any prior notice and assess and evaluate the performance, standards and benchmarks of such University or medical institution and if the college is found to be not maintaining the Minimum Essential standards as specified in the concerned Acts & Regulations then in accordance of Section 28 (1) (f) of NCISM Act, 2020 the issued permission of the college shall deemed to be withdrawn and denial of permission shall be issued by MARBISM for stoppage of admission for that particular academic year or the subsequent year.
- 9. Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM.
- 10. The following requirements should be fulfilled by the college by 31st December, 2024 and compliance report should be submitted to the MARB-ISM, in order to be considered for the grant of conditional permission for the academic session 2025-2026:
 - All the requirements under the provisions of the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled in toto
 - All the requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in ii) the NCISM (Minimum essential standards, assessment and rating for undergraduate Ayurveda colleges and attached teaching hospitals) Regulations, 2024.
 - All the requirements of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine (Minimum Standards of Undergraduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations, 2022;
 - iv) The shortcoming mentioned in Point no. 3 above.
- 11. The fulfillment of the conditions given above may be made within the time period specified and compliance report should be submitted by the college to President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine will verify that the conditions have been fulfilled for considering the permission for the academic session 2025-26.
